Literacy & English

We are learning to:

Explore and play with the patterns and sounds of language including identifying the sounds letters make and using these known sounds to word build 3 letter words.

Share our feelings and ideas on real and imaginative experiences in lots of different ways.

Recognise digraph sounds (two letters together which form a new sound such as ai, ee, oa).

Read some 'tricky' (words that do not follow phonic patterns such as 'all') words by sight.

Sequence events from stories in the correct order.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Money, number and measure

We are learning to:

Use materials such as stones, counters, and my fingers to help us understand adding.

Make quantities e.g. 5 is 1+4, 2+3

Recognise the + and = sign and vocabulary for them e.g. and, add, plus, makes, is, equals

Copy, create and continue simple patterns.

Shape, position and movement

We are learning to:

Sort and describe 2D and 3D shapes.

Use shapes in lots of different ways.

Context for Learning (Topic)

Once Upon a Time

We are learning about classic fairy tales through a storyline topic. We will learn about different characters, develop our listening and talking skills, take part in problem solving and explore art and technology.

RE

We are learning to:

Say the Hail Mary, Grace before Meals and Grace after Meals.

Understand that Mary is the Mother of Jesus and Our Mother.

Recognise that Christmas is a special time for Christians

Become familiar with the Christmas story and will know that at Christmas we celebrate the birth of Jesus who is the Son of God and the Son of Mary
