Number

We are learning to:

Use practical materials to investigate addition and subtraction and make links to the relationship between these processes

Explore and play with the patterns and sounds of language including identifying the sounds letters make and using these known sounds to word build 3 letter words.

Recognise digraph sounds (two letters together which form a new sound such as ai, ee, oa).

Read some 'tricky' (words that do not follow phonic patterns such as 'all') words by sight.

Talk and listen in small groups.

Describe 'Once Upon a Time' story characters and sequence events.
