Literacy & English

Listening & Talking

- Listen or watch for useful or interesting information and I use this to make choices or learn new things.

Reading

- Use signs, books or other texts to find useful or interesting information and use this to plan, make choices or learn new things.
- Use our phonetic knowledge and tricky words to help us read with fluency.

Writing

- Use our phonetic knowledge to help us write new words.
- Group words together to create sentences.
- Recognise or use capital letters and full stops

Numeracy & Mathematics

Angles, symmetry and transformation

- Use computer software and programmable toys such as The Bee-Bot.
- Create and identify symmetrical patterns and pictures.

Time

- Identify the hour and minute hand on an analogue clock.
- Read o'clock and half past times on an analogue clock.

Information Handling

- Organise information by grouping, matching or sorting.
- Collect information by conducting a simple survey or tally marks

Fractions, decimals and percentages

- Use language related to sharing e.g. .share, half, equal, bit, part
- Split objects, groups of items into smaller pieces/sets for the purpose of sharing equally/

- Continue to consolidate and develop knowledge and understanding of order and counting using numbers within 100.
