- to have confidence to try new activities and meet new friends

We are learning:

- through the Pope Francis Faith Award, to have understanding and to let the word of God have room in our lives

## Other Information

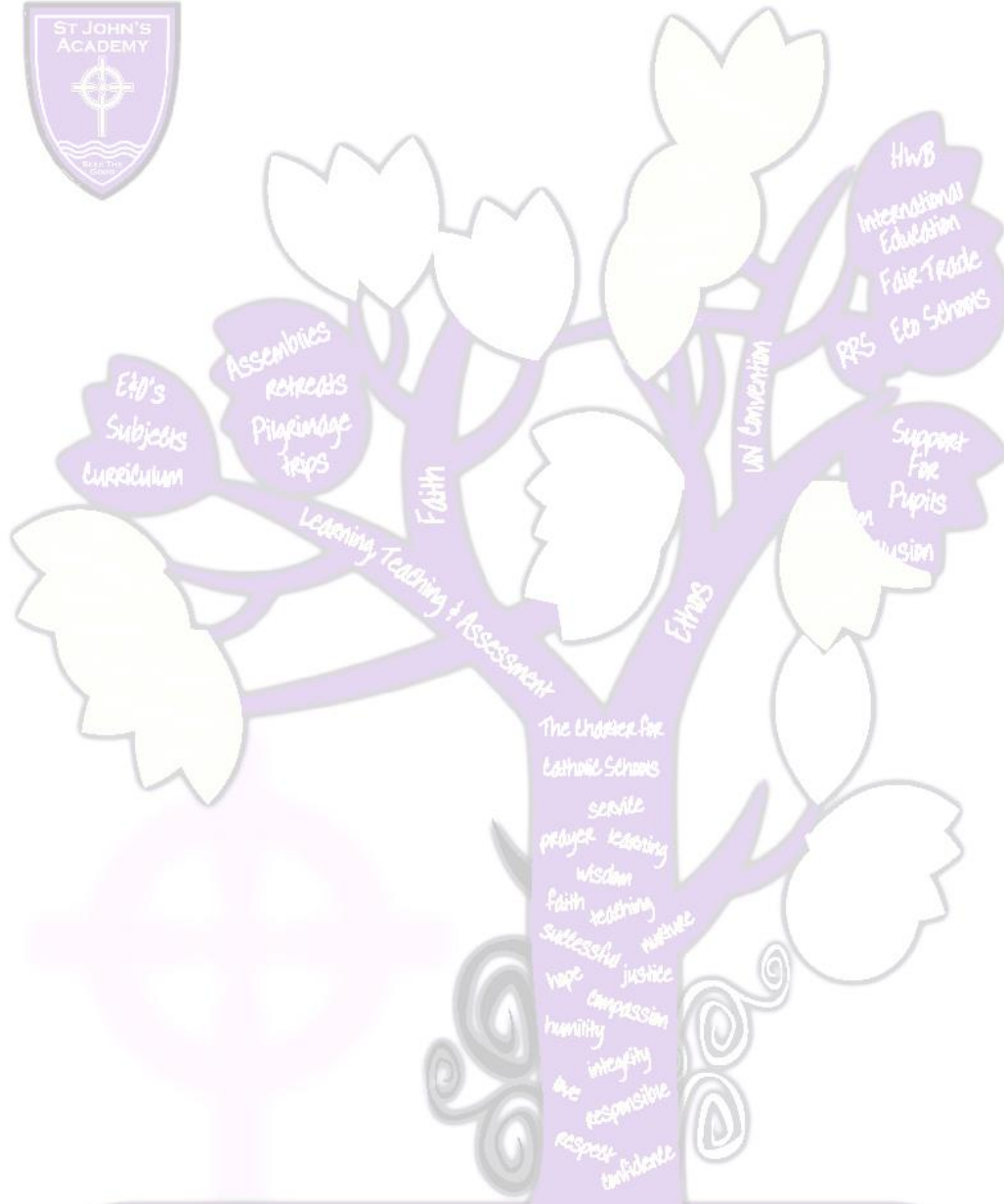
This term we are expecting pupils to regularly practise multiplication tables for instant recall before they start 51.
